Ordinance 2026-01 Renter's Utility Ordinance

All requests for utility services submitted by **renters** shall include a good faith deposit of \$100, which shall be refundable upon termination of service and payment of all outstanding utility service charges. In the event of the eviction or severance of long-term lease, the renter shall remain responsible for all utility charges accrued through the date the Village is notified to close the account. If the customer who is requesting utility services to be turned on has an outstanding account on another meter, the bill shall be paid in full when the deposit is paid before water is connected. In the event of the death of an account holder, the Village shall close the account upon receiving notice and reasonable documentation. The Village shall apply the renter's deposit (if applicable) to any outstanding charges, and remaining balance owed after application of the deposit shall be billed to the renter's estate in accordance with applicable law. **Upon termination of services, either by resident or due process by the Village, if the account is not paid within sixty (60) days of the termination date, the Village is authorized to pursue all lawful means of collection, including but not limited to referral to a third-party collections' agency, reporting delinquent accounts as permitted by law. Any fees incurred by the Village in the collection process may be added to the outstanding balance, as allowed by state and federal law.**

The Village must be in receipt of deposit before services can be activated.
